**CAIT demand technical audit of sewer and drainage system of Delhi and  
probe on huge money spent on sewer & drainage -CAIT  
The loss caused to the traders should be compensated**

Two days of rain in Delhi has exposed all the claims of Delhi government to make Delhi a world class city. Expressing serious concern over waterlogged roads all over Delhi and Delhi being converted into a river drain, the Confederation of All India Traders (CAIT) has demanded the Lieutenant Governor of Delhi, Shri VK Saxena, to conduct a technical audit of sewer and drainage system in Delhi and an immediate time bound probe on the huge money spent on Delhi's drainage and sewer system in last many years by Delhi Jal Board, Municipal Corporation of Delhi, Government of Delhi, New Delhi Municipal Council and other government agencies to find out where the money has been spent and if it was actually spent drainage and sewer then why Delhi roads has been converted into a river in just two days of rain?

CAIT's National Secretary General Mr. Praveen Khandelwal said that if this is the situation in Delhi after just two days of rain, then it is difficult to even imagine how bad Delhi will become during the monsoon. He said that Lieutenant Governor Mr. Saxena should immediately pay attention to this issue and take immediate steps as demanded by the CAIT

Mr Khandelwal further that due to the rains, the markets of Delhi have suffered a lot. Due to poor sewerage system in the markets, the roads have been doller with several feet of water and in many places the shops of traders have got flooded, due to which heavy loss of goods has been reported.He demanded that the Delhi government should immediately compensate the loss caused to the traders due to the negligence of the government agencies.
